Community hospitals like BID Milton play an essential and irreplaceable role in patient care. HIGH-QUALITY CARE CLOSE TO HOME

It's our privilege to care for you—and a responsibility we take very seriously. At BID Milton, you enjoy the compassion and friendliness of an outstanding community hospital along with the extensive resources of the Beth Israel Lahey Health network—including access to specialty tertiary care, delivered by renowned teams at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center in Boston, when needed.

Over the last decade—partly due to the closures of Quincy Medical Center and Carney Hospital—BID Milton has seen a tremendous increase in the number of both ED patients and inpatients. In 2020, we opened an urgent care clinic in Quincy, a source of additional patients to our ED. Our volume increased even more during the COVID-19 pandemic, which brought more and sicker patients to our ED.

While we're proud to be a reliable care destination for so many, we are challenged by a need for additional space. Our ED was built to serve 26,000 patients annually. Today, we see 40,000—a number that continues to grow. Meanwhile, over the last ten years, inpatient volume in our 100-bed hospital has increased by nearly fifty percent.

This ED expansion will provide greater flexibility and add significant inpatient capacity to meet the needs of acutely ill patients. Additional space and enhanced technology will also be meaningful—in particular for our staff. During a time when health care workers are experiencing significant stress and burnout, it is our duty to support our staff however possible. This includes providing facilities that enable them to do their jobs in an environment that is conducive to their wellness.
